Oklahoma Legislative

Bill Requires Oklahoma Businesses be Open during Pandemic |

On April 21, 2025, Oklahoma lawmakers passed Senate Bill 672, authored by Sen. Julie McIntosh (R-Porter) and Rep. Kevin West (R-Moore), which limits the governor's authority to close businesses during a declared pandemic. The bill, now awaiting Gov. Kevin Stitt's approval, requires scientific evidence proving a specific business contributes to disease spread before closure orders can be issued. It also mandates notice and a hearing for businesses deemed "nonessential," ensuring due process.

- **Oklahoma legislator wants federal family caregiver tax credit** |

Tammy West (R-Oklahoma City) urged Congress to adopt a federal version of Oklahoma's pioneering Caring for Caregivers Act through House Concurrent Resolution 1009. Oklahoma, the first state to implement a comprehensive caregiver tax credit in 2023, offers up to \$2,000 annually (or \$3,000 for caregivers of veterans or those with dementia) to offset out-of-pocket expenses. The proposed federal Credit for Caring Act, introduced by Ohio Congressman Mike Carey, would provide a refundable tax credit of up to \$5,000 for working family caregivers nationwide.

Key Points:

- **Oklahoma's Model:** The state's tax credit supports nearly 490,000 caregivers who provide \$6.6 billion in unpaid care annually, with average out-of-pocket costs of \$7,200 per year.
 - **Federal Proposal:** The Credit for Caring Act aims to ease financial burdens for caregivers, supported by Congressman Tom Cole and President Donald Trump.
 - **Impact:** Caregivers help keep loved ones out of costly nursing homes, saving taxpayers money. The resolution has been sent to Oklahoma's congressional delegation for action.
 - **Local Action:** Rep. West encourages Oklahomans to claim the state's tax credit for the 2024 tax year, with eligibility details at www.aarp.org/OKCaregiverTaxCredit.
 - This bipartisan effort highlights Oklahoma's leadership in supporting family caregivers and seeks to extend relief nationwide, addressing a critical need as caregiving costs rise.
- **Oklahoma Aerospace & Defense sees \$150 million capital investment**
<https://okbusinessvoice.com/2025/04/21/oklahoma-aerospace-defense-sees-150-million-capital-investment/> Oklahoma's aerospace and defense sector, the state's second-largest industry, achieved significant growth in 2024, securing \$146.6 million in new capital investment and creating 1,007 new jobs, according to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and Aerospace Commerce Economic Services (ACES). This milestone reinforces Oklahoma's position as a national leader in aerospace and defense, driven by its business-friendly policies and strategic initiatives.
