• Absorption of Northeast Workforce Development Board into Green Country Workforce Development Board: From 11 to 18 Counties

On July 1, 2025, the Green Country Workforce Development Board officially absorbed the Northeast Workforce Development Board, expanding its service area from 11 to 18 counties, now encompassing Adair, Cherokee, Craig, Creek, Delaware, Mayes, McIntosh, Muskogee, Nowata, Okmulgee, Osage, Ottawa, Pawnee, Rogers, Sequoyah, Tulsa, Wagoner, and Washington counties. This merger enhances the board's capacity to fuel economic development by connecting employers and job seekers through 6 American Job Centers and 6 Specialized Centers, offering comprehensive services like job placement, career counseling, and skills training.
