The American Job Center (AJC) offers free, personalized career support to help individuals explore options, set goals, and succeed. Services include:

## 1. Career Exploration & Guidance

- One-on-one career counseling and goal setting.
- Interest and skills assessments.
- Labor market information and career pathway planning.



## 2. Job Search Assistance

- Resume writing and interview preparation workshops.
- Access to job listings and employer connections.
- Support with online applications and job matching.



## 3. Training & Education

- Referrals to occupational skills training and certification programs.
- On-the-Job Training (OJT) and apprenticeships.
- Adult education, English Second Language (ESL), and GED preparation.



## 4. Supportive Services

- Transportation, childcare, and work-related expense assistance.
- Referrals to housing, food, and health services.
- Access to community resources and wraparound support.

- Computer labs and internet access.




