FREE TAX PREP

February 2 - April 15, 2026

Cherokee Nation Commerce Services, in partnership with the IRS, is offering free tax preparation services for individuals and families whose total household income is \$69,000 or less.

Please bring the following documents to your tax appointment:

- A valid photo ID
- Social Security cards or ITIN documentation for you, your spouse, and any dependents
- All wage and income statements, including:
 - Forms W-2, W-2G, 1099-MISC, and 1099-R
 - Interest and dividend statements from banks or financial institutions (Forms 1099-INT and 1099-DIV)
 - Social Security benefit statements (SSA-1099), if applicable
 - Marketplace Health Insurance statements (Form 1095-A), if applicable
- Proof of childcare expenses, if applicable
- A copy of your prior year's federal and state tax returns, if available
- Your Identity Protection PIN (IP PIN), if issued by the IRS
- Proof of bank routing and account numbers for direct deposit (such as a voided or blank check)

The American Job Center (AJC) offers free, personalized career support to help individuals explore options, set goals, and succeed. Services include:

1. Career Exploration & Guidance

- One-on-one career counseling and goal setting.
- Interest and skills assessments.
- Labor market information and career pathway planning.

2. Job Search Assistance

- Resume writing and interview preparation workshops.
- Access to job listings and employer connections.
- Support with online applications and job matching.

3. Training & Education

- Referrals to occupational skills training and certification programs.
- On-the-Job Training (OJT) and apprenticeships.
- Adult education, English Second Language (ESL), and GED preparation.

4. Supportive Services

- Transportation, childcare, and work-related expense assistance.
- Referrals to housing, food, and health services.
- Access to community resources and wraparound support.

5. Digital Literacy & Tech Access

- Computer labs and internet access.
- Digital Literacy Labs and tech-enabled self-service tools.
- Help with email setup, online job applications, and virtual interviews.

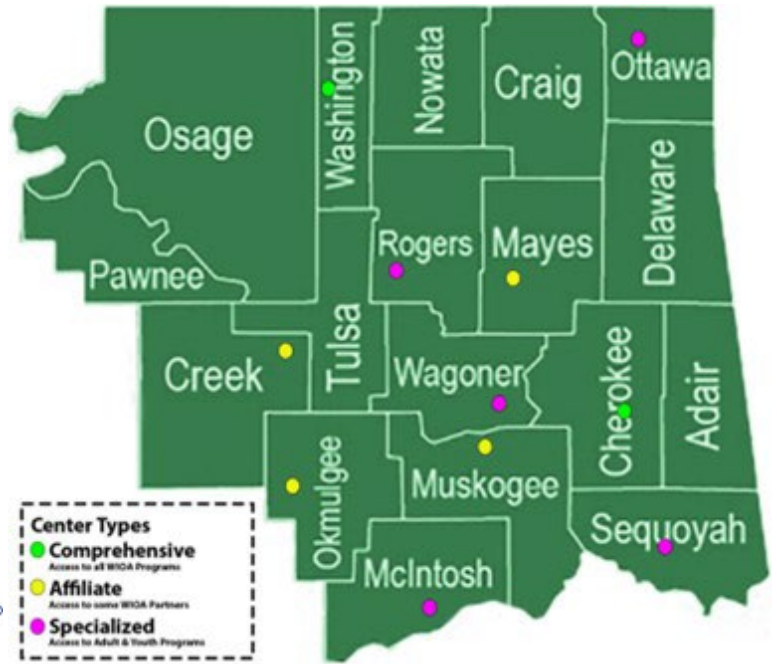

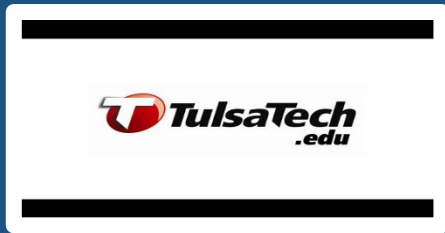

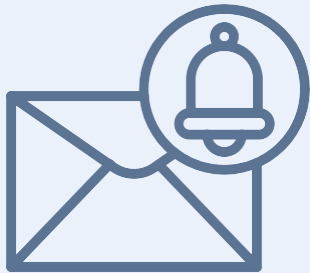
